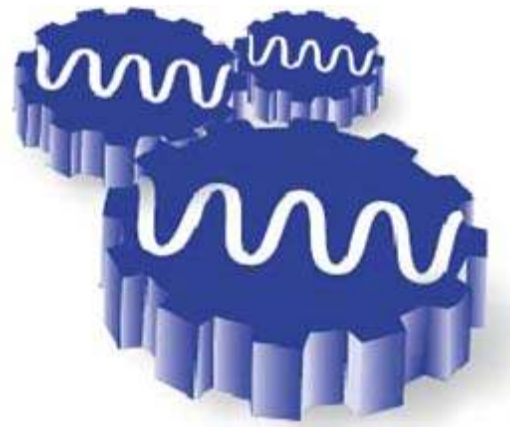


Electrical Safety for Qualified Electrical Workers



WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

- Electrical Hazards Awareness
- Safe work procedures for work on metal-clad switchgear, substations, motor control centers and facility electrical systems.
- Proper care and maintenance, selection and use of required personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Energized and de-energized work policy and lockout/tagout requirements.
- Grounding of electrical systems and specific equipment hazards.
- Review of OSHA Electrical Safety-Related Work Practice regulations (29CFR 1910.331-.335) as well as Articles 110, 120 and 130 of the NFPA 70E.

HOW YOU'LL BENEFIT

- Recognize and avoid electrical safety hazards and develop and implement a course of action to address each hazard.
- Plan the required steps needed to work safely on or near energized conductors and circuit parts.
- Examine and determine work tasks and choose the appropriate personal protective equipment.
- Ascertain the hazard risk category classification of a particular task.
- Perform absence of voltage testing to insure an electrically-safe work condition.
- Perform inspections of required PPE and equipment to ensure it is safe to use.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- All technicians, field-service personnel, electricians, supervisors and engineers who supervise employees that work on or near energized equipment and are classified as "qualified" by OSHA.

PREREQUISITES

- Attendees should have basic electrical training. Field experience recommended but not mandatory.
